

## Professorship (W3) in Training and Movement Sciences

Candidates with expertise preferably in several areas of Athletic Training, Exercise Science and Kinesiology are encouraged to apply. The successful candidate will be expected to establish and maintain a vigorous research program and assume teaching responsibilities in the field of Exercise Training and Movement Sciences at the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Successful candidates will be of international reputation and demonstrate an outstanding record of academic achievement including excellent publications in renowned journals. Experiences in developing, implementing and managing large scale interdisciplinary research projects are required. A relevant teaching record and proofs of securing competitive extramural funding are a must. Work relations to and co-operation with professional and scientific societies are expected. Candidates have to demonstrate their capabilities to lead research groups of young scientists.

Since this professorship involves teacher training, the candidate should have relevant experience in this area. He/She will also be expected to participate in multi-disciplinary initiatives in the field of empirical educational research.

The applicant should engage in the administration of the area of sports of all programs of the Institute of Sports Sciences. In addition, the incumbent will be expected to contribute to the development of an academic curriculum of Coaching Certification Programs.

Candidates must have a graduate degree in Sports Sciences, an excellent doctorate degree in an appropriate area within or related to Exercise Training and Movement Sciences as well as a Habilitation, or an equivalent internationally acknowledged qualification.

The designated salary for the position is based on “W3” on the German university scale or equivalent.
