Duties and Responsibilities:

Assistant Professor: Teach courses in Human Movement and Biomechanics, Basic and Sports Nutrition, Beginning and Advanced Care and Prevention of Injury, Tests, Measurement and Statistics, and related courses; advise students; engage in scholarly activity; seek extramural funding for research; and provide departmental, school, university, and professional service. The successful applicant will teach face to face and distance learning courses, service, GE (general education) and major courses, on-campus classes and classes around Hawai'i Island as needed and assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

Assistant Professor: Doctorate in Kinesiology, Human Performance, Exercise Physiology, or related field from an accredited college or university. Documented experience and excellence in teaching. Established record in research.

Associate Professor: In addition to the Assistant Professor as stated above; minimum of five (5) years of full-time college or university teaching at the rank of Assistant Professor; documentation of high quality teaching performance, high quality scholarly and/or creative contributions and service to the academic life of a college.

Professor: In addition to the Associate Professor as stated above; minimum of five (5) years of full-time college or university teaching at the rank of Associate Professor or higher.

Desirable Qualifications:

Experience in course development. Experience working in multi-cultural settings, and with Native Hawaiian and/or other Indigenous populations; active research program in exercise sciences; experience in grant writing and grant management.

Pay range:

Commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Submit a resume, letter of application, CV, reprints, evidence of teaching effectiveness, three (3) letters of recommendation, and transcript(s) showing degrees and course work appropriate to the position (copies are acceptable, however original official transcripts will be required prior to employment).
