The position will be part-time (50 %) and limited to 3 years, with the objective of scientific qualification.

Employment is within the frame of the interdisciplinary research project "Flexibility in Multitasking: Impact of Predictability in Visuomotor Performance" (together with Prof. Dr. Dr. Markus Raab, Institute of Psychology at the German Sport University Cologne and Dr. Rita de Oliveira, LSBU, London, UK). It is sponsored by the German Research Foundation within the framework of the Priority Program 1772 "Human Performance under Multiple Cognitive Task Requirements: From Basic Mechanisms to Optimized Task Scheduling" for a period of 36 months.

Tasks:

- Execution of the applied project
- Conception, programming, executing and evaluating experiments
- Publishing the project results
- Cooperation within the activities of the Priority Program 1772

Required are:

- University degree in science, preferably in psychology or sports science

Expected are:

- Programming skills (e.g. C++, Matlab, ...)
- Experience in experimental methods
- Experience in publishing in international scientific journals
- Motivated in scientific work within a research group
- Excellent English language skill written and oral
- Interest in gaining a doctorate in the intersection of psychology and movement science
- Specific qualification or interest in the acknowledged areas

The applicant with the required qualifications will be remunerated in accordance with 13 TV-L federal state.

The denoted qualifications must be substantiated by appropriate certificates. The University of Augsburg wants to increase the fraction of women and therefore encourages the application of qualified female applicants. Women will be given preference, unless there are prevailing rational reasons in the person of a co-applicant. Upon equal qualification, applicants with a handicap will be given preference.
